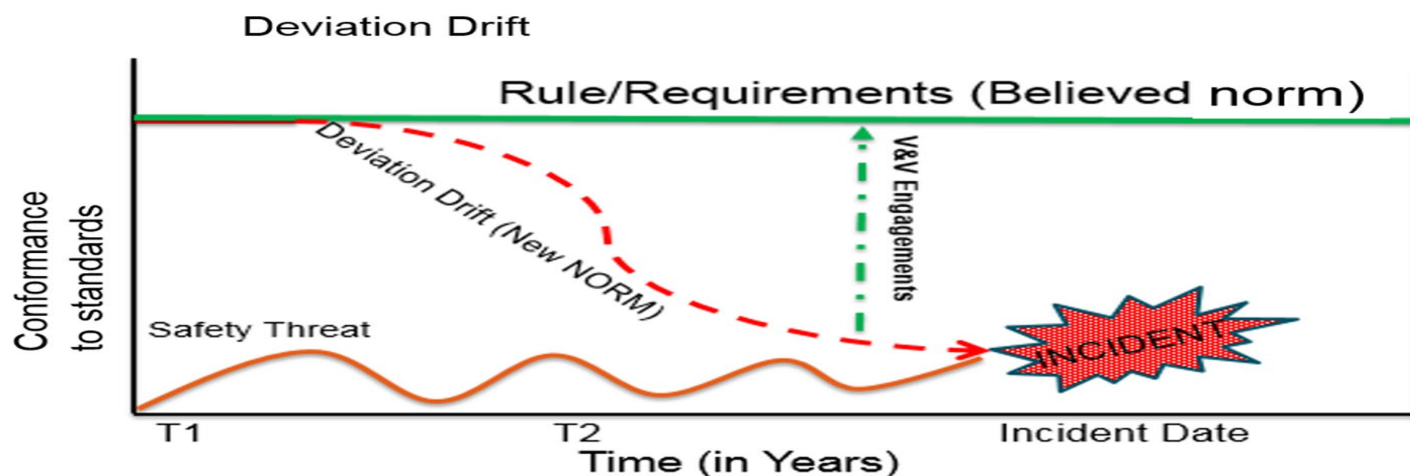

Date: 07-11-19	Title: BBS Trends, PPE & Eye Protection	

The BBS Observation trends for the previous month revealed an increased number of unsafe behaviors related to eye protection. All personnel working on GVTY property shall wear appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE). It is the responsibility of everyone to bring and to wear PPE as required by the specific task being performed, the potential hazards that person will be exposed to, and the specifics of the job site.



The appropriate level of face and eye protection shall be determined by a risk assessment of the job to be performed. At a minimum, safety glasses are required at all jobsites.

- All face and eye protection shall meet ANSI Z87.1 standards.
- ANSI Z87.1 approved safety glasses with side shields shall be worn at all times. If prescription glasses must be worn, personnel shall either:
 - Wear prescription glasses with lenses, frames and side shields meeting ANSI Z87.1 standards, or
 - Wear eye protection over the prescription glasses that meet ANSI Z87.1 standard.

Types:

- Safety Glasses- for the impact protection of the eyes.
- Face Shields- for splash and impact protection of the face.
- Goggles- for chemical or (hot/cold) liquid splash hazard, torch cutting and/or projectile hazards.
- Welding Helmets- for welding flash burn protection. Welders and helpers shall wear eye protection which complies with the minimum listed in 29 CFR 1910.133(a) (5) for welding shades. Other features of welding eye protection shall comply with ANSI Z49.1
